## MACTE Fee Schedule

July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025
MACTE's operations are supported primarily by annual dues and Adult Learner fees from accredited programs, MACTE recognized organizations (MROs), and consortia of independent institutions. All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

| A late fee is charged if Annual Dues are not paid within 90 days of the due date. <br> A late submission fee will be required if a Renewal Self-Study is submitted after the due date outlined in the Renewal timeline. <br> A late submission fee will be required if a program fails to submit their annual report within 30 days of the annual report submission deadline. <br> A program that receives a negative status decision has the right to request reconsideration and/or appeal the decision. | Late Annual Dues Fee | $15 \%$ of balance |
